


PA:

The reinforcement system has to be suitable for the dimensions of the concert venue. It should provide enough power for an SPL of 100 dBA at every listening position in the venue (minimum: 3way active). It should be possible to reach an satisfying listing situation at every position in the audience.

FOH:

Console: 30 mono-inputs, 4 stereo-returns, mind. 12 auxilary-sends; The input-channels should offer following facilities: input-pad, lowcut, phantom-power, phase-invert, parametric 4-band-EQ.

A HIGH QUALITY DIGITAL-MIXING-DESK IS ALSO WELCOME (MIDAS, YAMAHA, DIGICO)

OUTBOARD:

- 1 Stereo-3-band-EQ for the reinforcement system (Klark, BSS or DBX).
- 5 Compressors und 5 Gates (Drawner, BSS or DBX)
- 2 professional Reverb-Units (Lexicon, TC-Electronics, Yamaha)

If its possible, the position of the FOH should be in the middle of the audience in front of the middle of the stage. A sound-engineer who is familiar with the reinforcement system should stand by during the soundcheck and the concert.

SOUNDCHECK:

The reinforcement system has to work and be free of any hum or other disturbing noises when the musicians arriving at the venue. Two stagehands should stand by to unload and set up the backline. After the microphones are placed a soundcheck-time of 1 hour should be calculated. The setup on the mixing-console has to stay untouched until the concert. Any limits of soundpressure-level have to be discussed bevore the soundcheck.

MONITOR:

The ensemble needs 7 high-quality wedges with appropriate amping on 7 seperate auxilary-sends pre fade plus 4 effect sends. A 32-band-graphic-EQ should be inserted in each send.

2 Electric Basses: 4-String Fender Precision or Jazzbass with Flat Wound (!!) Strings

2 Electric Bass Stands + 2 Double Bass Stands

2 Bass-Amplifiers: TOP/HEAD: Gallien Krüger RB1001 or RB700 or MarkBass

BOX: 4x10" Cabinet minimum

1 Combo-Bass-Amplifier: MarkBass CMD121p 1x12" or similar



PLEASE NOTE THAT WE NEED 3 BASS AMPLIFIERS IN TOTAL!

VERY IMPORTANT:

Always place the Bass Amps on a box or sim. with a height of at least 1,5 meter so that the speaker is as close to the bass players ears as possible
